REGISTRATION

GENERAL INFORMATION

Hungary belongs to the European Union, but not to the "Euro zone". The local currency is Hungarian Forint (HUF): currently 1 euro ~ 270 HUF, but fluctuating.

Please check if you need a visa for visiting Hungary. If for visa /or for any reason ©/ you need an official letter of invitation, please let us know as soon as possible.

Budapest is a magnificent city with approximately two million inhabitants. It lies on the banks of the River Danube and has considerable historical heritage and cultural life.

The Rényi Institute (formerly: Mathematical Research Institute of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences) is Hungary's no. 1 mathematical centre with about 1/3 of the total publications by Hungarian mathematicians /that is, more than ½ % of the world's total output ©/ coming from the staff here. It is located in central downtown Budapest, on the Pest side of the Danube, close to public transportation (e.g. metro lines) and points of interest. Simple but large, clean and reasonable guest rooms without further services (e.g. no breakfast), but ample facilities for self-service (microwave oven, some kitchen facilities etc.). There are 2-bed rooms for approx 35 EUR and we could reserve a 2x2 bed apartment, for around 55 EUR, and suggest to share. Reservation is possible only through the organizers! Since we have only a limited number of places, if your choice is this one, please give a second choice as well, in case we can not put you to this place.

A *** hotel for 70 EUR per night for single occupancy. Under a special discount program for 3 nights reserved the 4th night is free. However, even better, there is a special package for guests of our Institute: 54 EUR for a single and 68 EUR for a double room per night. This package is only available through the organizers! Therefore, if this hotel is your choice, we strongly suggest you to make your reservation through the organizers.

Clean, good, spacious 2-bed rooms with TV and refrigerator, having a nice, panoramic view of part of Buda (but not the Danube) - however, lack of air condition might be a problem in warm, sunny weather. Price: 12.300 HUF/night/room or 7.175 HUF/night/person.

MEALS

In principle, we do not plan to organize meals. Nevertheless, during the lunch break we plan to visit nearby restaurants together with those, who wish to join us. There are plenty of restaurants around, e.g. pizzeria, McDonald's, Burger King, Chinese food, Döner kebab, traditional Hungarian and international style restaurants, self-service restaurants, Hotel Astoria etc., the prices ranging from 600 HUF (2.10 EUR) to 6000 HUF (21 EUR), depending on meals and the category of the restaurants. Also coffee shops (non-Amsterdam type), bars, food stores are abundant in the area. Let us know if you are on some special diet or have any particular requirements regarding meals: we try our best to assist you in finding what you like.

Registration includes refreshments in coffee-breaks. As of now, we are not sure if we can offer together with the registration the full access to the social programs including meals. When our application for support will be answered, we inform you on these details.
