VI. ERC Workshop on data access under the Digital Services Act (DSA) Article 40

The Digital Services Act (DSA) is a European legislation that specifies a set of rules to make the digital space safer and more trustworthy for users. It is applicable to all online intermediaries, for example online marketplaces, social networks, content-sharing platforms, app stores, and online travel and accommodation platforms. It applies in a proportionate way: the bigger the intermediary, the more stringent their obligations. The impact of this legal provision will be extensive for researchers worldwide. It opens up new avenues for research on 'systemic risks' linked to the platforms' services in the EU.

Article 40 of the DSA brings unprecedented opportunities for researchers to access data from very large online platforms and search engines (VLOPs and VLOSEs). It is also essential for researchers to grasp the breadth and procedures outlined in DSA Article 40 for both ongoing and future projects. Additionally, exchanging experiences and best practices among researchers focused on systemic risks and mitigation strategies can enhance their collective endeavours within the research community.

The European Mission Soil Week (EMSW) is an annual event aimed at promoting the Horizon Europe Mission 'A Soil Deal for Europe' - Mission Soil - raising awareness about the importance of soil health and driving action to protect and restore our soils. The 2025 edition is organised by the Danish Ministry of Green Transition, Aarhus University, and the European Commission's Directorate-General for Agriculture and Rural Development, under the auspices of the Danish Presidency of the Council of the EU. It will take place on 5 – 6 November 2025 at Aarhus University, Denmark.

This edition focuses on investments and business models for soil health, recognising the growing momentum of public and private actors in channelling resources toward sustainable land management. With an estimated financing gap of over EUR 100 billion in agriculture alone, there is an urgent need to scale up investment and innovation across all land use sectors.

EMSW 2025 offers a unique platform to connect diverse stakeholders - including policymakers, researchers, land managers, financial institutions, businesses, philanthropies, and citizens. Through sessions, exhibitions, and networking, participants will explore practical models and inspiring solutions to accelerate the transition to sustainable soil management.

The International Science Council is proud to partner for the fourth year with the Frontiers Planet Prize in recognizing and rewarding research with the greatest potential to address the ecological crisis. It's the world's biggest prize for transformative, science-based breakthroughs to enable healthy lives on a healthy planet.

The Frontiers Planet Prize is a global competition for scientists and research institutions to propose solutions to help the planet remain within the safe operating space of any one or more of the 9 planetary boundaries. The prize aims to mobilize nations and the global community of scientists conducting research on earth system science. Three prizes worth a total of USD 3 million will be awarded in this fourth edition to the world's most innovative sustainability research offering globally scalable solutions for protecting and restoring planetary health. All domains of science are eligible.

The Planet Prize will honour research published in established peer-reviewed scientific journals in the past two calendar years (date of acceptance: 1 November 2023 to 31 October 2025) that has the greatest potential to help keep the Earth system within planetary boundaries. All submitted research must be in English.
