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I. Pályázati felhívás gyermeket nevelő kutatók támogatására - 2026

A Magyar Tudományos Akadémia elnöki határozat alapján pályázatot ír ki a gyermeket nevelő kutatók tudományos előmenetelének elősegítése érdekében az alábbi két kategóriában:

1. kategória: az MTA doktora cím megszerzéséhez szükséges értekezés megírásának támogatása a 14. életévét be nem töltött gyermeket nevelő kutatók (nők és egyedülálló férfiak) számára;

2. kategória: a tudományos eredmények publikálásának támogatása olyan kutatók esetében, akikre teljesülnek az alábbi feltételek:

- a pályázó legkisebb gyermekének születésétől kevesebb, mint négy év telt el a pályázat benyújtásáig. Férfiak esetén ez a feltétel kiegészül azzal, hogy ez alatt az idő alatt legalább egy évet a kutató igazolhatóan, folyamatosan gyerekgondozással (CSÉD/GYED/GYES) otthon töltött, vagy a pályázás ideje alatt gyerekgondozás miatt (CSÉD/GYED/GYES) otthon van.

vagy

- a pályázó 14. életévét be nem töltött, fogyatékkal élő vagy tartósan beteg gyermeket nevel.

A pályázat keretében az 1. kategóriában pályázók esetében nyertes pályázónként bruttó 3 000 000 Ft, a 2. kategóriában pályázók esetében pedig nyertes pályázónként bruttó 600 000 Ft összegű vissza nem térítendő ösztöndíj-támogatás nyerhető el. A támogatást a kedvezményezett 2026. május 1. és 2027. április 30. között veheti igénybe, választhatóan három, négy, hat, nyolc vagy tizenkét hónapos időtartammal, az időtartamnak megfelelő hónaponkénti bontásban.

II. Call for authors: Eighth edition of UNESCO Science Report

UNESCO invites qualified experts to contribute to the upcoming eighth edition of the UNESCO Science Report (USR), the Organization's flagship publication that monitors global trends in Science, Technology, and Innovation (STI).

For the eighth edition, we aim to gather diverse and insightful voices from across science, technology, and innovation studies, forming balanced author teams that combine experienced scholars with emerging researchers, and ensure gender and geographical diversity.

UNESCO invites authors and reviewers with demonstrated expertise and experience in one or more of the following or related areas:

- National, regional, or global STI systems
- Science policy analysis, monitoring, and evaluation
- Research and innovation for sustainable development
- Digital transformation, open science, and emerging technologies
- Gender equality in science, technology, and innovation
- Science education, capacity development, and knowledge systems.
- Existential challenges and systemic resilience
- Climate resilience and sustainability
- Disruptive technologies and societal impacts
- Roles and responsibilities

Authors will be responsible for drafting the different chapters of the report based on agreed outlines and guidelines provided by UNESCO. Reviewers will provide constructive feedback to ensure the scientific accuracy, coherence, and policy relevance of the draft chapters. Both authors and reviewers will collaborate closely with the UNESCO Secretariat and the Editorial Board to ensure the highest quality standards and consistency across the report. Contributors will join a global network of experts supporting UNESCO's mission to advance open, inclusive, and responsible science.

Selected contributors will be notified by 15th December and will receive detailed guidance and timelines for the preparation and review of chapters.

V. Call for sessions for the conference “*Towards a just and habitable world: exploring the role of technology*”

The conference will be hosted by University of Lausanne (UNIL) in cooperation with the Centre des Politiques de la Terre (Université Paris-Cité) and the Future Earth Pathways Initiative. It will be held on 3-5 June, 2026 with a welcome event on June 2, 2026.

This conference invites researchers from across the natural and social sciences, engineering, and the humanities, as well as scholars and practitioners engaged in inter- and transdisciplinary research, to critically examine the role of technology in shaping sustainability. We will explore how technological systems — past, present, and emerging — have the potential to both sustain and undermine well-being and life on Earth for humans and non-humans.

Under the main theme – *Towards a just and habitable world: exploring the role of technology* – we welcome proposals for poster presentations, thematic and workshop sessions, as well as cultural events. Posters and sessions may address one or more of the ten thematic tracks outlined below. You may also propose posters and sessions outside these tracks as long as they demonstrate their contribution to the conference’s main theme.

The conference is an on-site only event. Sessions can include a presentation from another location, but it needs to be fully arranged by the session organisers. Virtual presentations still entail registration costs. Each person can appear up to two times in the programme as session convener or co-convener. This limit does not include poster presentations.

VI. Call for Proposals for ERC Consolidator Grant (ERC-2026-COG)

The Consolidator Grant supports excellent Principal Investigators who are consolidating their own independent research team or programme. A Consolidator Grant Principal Investigator should have already shown evidence of research independence.

Consolidator Grants may be awarded up to a maximum of EUR 2 000 000 for a period of 5 years. The maximum size of the grants is reduced pro rata temporis for proposals of shorter duration.

Additional funding up to EUR 1 000 000 can be requested to cover further eligible costs (e.g. start-up costs, major equipment, access to large facilities, major experimental and field work costs) when these are necessary to carry out the proposed work. The requests for additional funding must be duly justified in the proposal. The maximum amount of the grant is reduced pro rata temporis for proposals of shorter duration. Additional funding is not subject to pro rata temporis reduction for projects of shorter duration. Both the grant amount requested, as well as any additional funding are assessed during evaluation.

The Principal Investigators shall have successfully defended their first PhD at least 7 and up to 12 years prior to 1 January 2026. Cut-off dates: Successful defence of PhD between 1 January 2014 and 31 December 2018 (inclusive). The eligibility period can be extended beyond 7 years in certain properly documented circumstances.

VII. 2026 WDS Data Stewardship Award

The World Data System (WDS) Data Stewardship Award celebrates individuals who have significantly improved the quality, integrity, and accessibility of research data. Ideal candidates are those who manage and/or curate data with exceptional care at all stages – from design to reuse – while adhering to legal, policy, and ethical guidelines.

This prestigious award recognizes outstanding contributions to data stewardship and the advancement of Open Science across all disciplines.

Nominees should have a track record of:

- Ensuring excellent data management and/or curation throughout its lifecycle
- Adhering to applicable laws and policies
- Contributing significantly to enhancing the quality, integrity, and accessibility of data and metadata
- Be within ten (10) years of their Master's degree, PhD, or equivalent professional training

Any Early Career Data Steward can be nominated for this award! Candidates may apply themselves or be suggested by a peer or an organization. To be considered eligible, candidates will need to submit an application, a resume, and three (3) reference letters.
