II. Call for Papers: Global Water Security Issue 7 – Water and Gender: Towards Equality in Rights and Opportunities

The United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organisation (UNESCO) Intergovernmental Hydrological Programme (IHP) and the International Centre for Water Security and Sustainable Management (i-WSSM), under the auspices of UNESCO, cordially invite research scientists, practitioners, and experts from international organisations, government agencies, non-profit institutions, and the private sector to submit proposals/abstracts for the upcoming Issue 7 of the Global Water Security Issues (GWSI) Series.

Planned for publication in 2026-2027, Issue 7 will focus on the theme “Water and Gender”, with a particular emphasis on women’s rights and equal opportunities in the context of water resources access and management.

Proposals (abstracts) should be submitted using the proposal template. Selected authors will be invited to further develop their submissions into full draft chapters. These chapters, that shall be original, high-quality research or policy analysis not previously published elsewhere, will undergo a rigorous peer-review process, with only accepted submissions included in GWSI Issue 7.

IV. Call for nominations of experts for second global assessment of biodiversity and ecosystem services

In line with decision IPBES-11/1 and the procedures for the preparation of IPBES deliverables, the Multidisciplinary Expert Panel invites qualified experts to apply, and Governments and relevant organizations to nominate experts to participate in the second global assessment.

The overall objective of the second IPBES global assessment of biodiversity and ecosystem services is to assess relevant knowledge that has become available since the publication in 2019 of *The Global Assessment Report on Biodiversity and Ecosystem Services* and to assess progress towards achieving the goals of sustainability and living in harmony with nature. Moreover, it will strengthen the science-policy interface on biodiversity and nature's contributions to people on a range of spatial scales, from the local to the global, by providing the knowledge and the policy support tools needed for informed decision-making.

Experts should have experience in the conduct of regional and global analyses relating to nature and nature's contributions to people in terrestrial, inland water, coastal and marine ecosystems. They should have expertise relevant to the global assessment of biodiversity and ecosystem services in one or more disciplines within natural science, social science or humanities. IPBES is, in particular, seeking experts with an interdisciplinary background.

V. Data Repository Investment Value & Relevance

The World Data System (WDS) and its Scientific Committee are launching a study to identify the value-added benefits of data repositories, in order to address the WDS Action Plan Objective #2 to advance value narratives for WDS members. The ultimate goal of this project is to demonstrate the value of repositories in serving needs of researchers, funders, policy-makers and other stakeholders. To this end, organisers chose the Delphi Study method to identify the top 10 value-added benefits that data repositories provide to the international research ecosystem, now and into the next decade. The research team is comprised of World Data System – International Technology Office (WDS-ITO) staff and WDS Scientific Committee members.

Individuals that identify as one of the target groups (funders, publishers, researchers, policy makers, and digital infrastructure/service providers) are asked to participate as key stakeholders of data repositories. Participation in this project is entirely voluntary.

Round 1 is expected to take the longest, as it will be the first exposure to the attribute list that has been compiled. We anticipate no more than an hour of effort. The subsequent rounds are estimated to take less than 30 minutes each. All disseminated results will be anonymized.

VI. Open Access to JRC Research Infrastructures

The European Commission's Joint Research Centre (JRC) opens its scientific laboratories and facilities to people working in academia and research organisations, industry, small and medium enterprises (SMEs), and more in general to the public and private sector.

The JRC offers access to its non-nuclear facilities to researchers and scientists from EU Member States and countries associated to the EU Research Programme Horizon Europe. For nuclear facilities, the JRC opens to EU Member States and to countries associated to the Euratom Research Programme.

The relevance-driven access is exclusively dependent on scientific and socio-economic relevance at European level. It is based on a peer-review selection process following a call for proposals. Projects accessing JRC facilities under the relevance-driven mode are only charged the additional costs associated to such access. Market-driven access is granted upon payment of a fee covering the full access costs of the JRC, and it is mainly targeted to industry.

In total, there are 13 open calls at the moment. Please note that the application deadlines may differ.
